On-Farm Experiences

LARGE GROUP ON-FARM VISITS

Recommended for: Schools, daycares, youth groups

Group Size: 20 - 50 children

Focus: Hands-on, presentation-based learning

Availability: May to October

Visit Length: Minimum 3 hours at the farm (*recommended*)

Ages: Kindergarten to Grade 3

Price: \$8.00 + tax per child

Option 1: Guided Farm Tour

Recommended for: First time visitors

Structured & rotational schedule  *Divide into 2 or 3 smaller groups*

Guided educational farm visits  *45 - 60 minutes per tour*

Free play & lunch break scheduled  *20 minute tractor rides*

Option 2: Self-Guided Visit

Recommended for: Returning groups or flexible schedules

Flexible experience & schedule  *Divide into small groups of choice*

Explore farm at your own pace  *Mini timed farm presentations*

Access to play areas and animals  *20 minute timed tractor rides*

SMALL GROUP ON-FARM VISITS

Recommended for: Schools, daycares, youth groups

Group Size: 10 - 20 children

Focus: Hands-on, activity-based learning with more in-depth exploration

Availability: February to November

Visit Length: Minimum 3 hours at the farm (*recommended*)

Program Duration: 2 hours

Price: \$10.00+tax per child



Little Farmer's (Gr. 2 - 4)



Fun and hands-on introduction to farm life and various career opportunities in agriculture including farmers, agronomists, veterinarians, agricultural engineers, and more!

Activity: Mini farm career exploration



Honey Bees & Beekeeping (Gr. 2 - 4)



Learn all about the fascinating world of honey bees – explore what's inside the hive, how bees make honey, their life cycle, and how they help the environment. Dive into beekeeping and explore beekeeping tools.

Activity: Honey tasting & bee craft



Sheep to Yarn (K - Gr. 3)



Learn how wool goes from sheep to finished products. Discover how to care for sheep, the shearing process, and the steps to turning wool into finished products.

Activity: Wool felting craft



Dairy Day (K - Grade 4)



Learn all about milk & dairy farming. Explore where milk comes from, dairy products, mammals, and the history of dairy farming.

Small Animal Packages

ONE-ON-ONE ANIMAL INTERACTIONS

Recommended for: Community homes, preschoolers

Focus: Animal interaction, conversation driven, one-on-one

Availability: Year-Round (Indoors only November-April)

Group Sizes: 5-10 people at a time

Price: \$160+tax minimum 2 hours

Additional Time: \$50+tax per hour

Travel: Covers up to 50 km from the farm; extra fees for up to 100 km



ALL ABOUT FARMING

Recommended for: Schools, daycares, youth groups

Focus: Educational, hands-on, presentation based

Availability: May to October

Group Sizes: 15-20 kids

Duration: 30 minutes per group

Price: \$210+tax minimum 2 hours

Additional Time: \$60+tax per hour

Travel: Covers up to 50 km from the farm; extra fees for up to 100 km

Farm to You Visits

Seasonal & Themed Programs

CHICKS & BUNNIES

Recommended for: Schools, daycares, youth groups, community homes

Availability: March & April

Group Sizes: 10-15 kids

Duration: 15 minutes per group

Price: \$210+tax minimum 2 hours

Additional Time: \$60+tax per hour

Travel: Covers up to 50 km from the farm; extra fees for up to 100 km



EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS (WITHOUT ANIMALS)

Recommended for: Schools, daycares, youth groups

Focus: Educational, hands-on learning, activity based

Availability: Year Round (Indoor only)

Group Sizes: 20-25 kids

Duration: 1 hour per group

Price: \$210+tax minimum 2 hours

Additional Time: \$60+tax per hour

Travel: Covers up to 50 km from the farm; extra fees for up to 100 km
